(NOTICE) APPLICATION FOR NEW RESIDENTS AT THE INTERNATIONAL HOUSE FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING October 2020

To All International Students,

We are pleased to announce that rooms at the International House will be available for rent. Those who wish to reside at the International House should read the following information carefully before submitting their applications.

1. Eligibility:

International students registered at the University of the Ryukyus (except those enrolled as auditors).

2. Rooms and Period of Residence:

Couple and Family Room: **[Building C] : 1** (25,000 yen per month)
[Building E] : 1 (25,000 yen per month)

From October 1, 2020 (Thu.) to September 17, 2021 (Fri.)

3. What to submit:

Application form for Residence at International House

4. Application Period:

From July 27, 2020 (Mon.) to July 31, 2020 (Fri.)

5. Place to submit the form:

Application form should be submitted to the Global Education Section.

6. Selection Process:

The priority for permission of residence will be given in the following order: those who are new to Japan and the university; those who are new to the university; and those who have never lived in the International House before. Among those who have previously lived in the International House, preference will be given to applicants with shorter periods of residence. If there is more than one applicant fulfilling the same priority criteria, selection of applicants will be decided by a drawing of lots.

7. Meeting:

Selected applicants will be announced, and a drawing of lots will be held (if necessary) at **4:30 P.M. on Wednesday August 5, 2020 at the International House.** It is compulsory for all applicants to be present at the meeting. **Please be on time.** If you are unable to attend, you must designate a proxy to attend the meeting on your behalf, or your application will be denied.

8. Notes:

*Application form is available at the Global Education Section.

*Any application which is delivered by mail or which is incomplete will not be accepted.

*Please remember, in the case that any students who obtain permission for residence do not move into the International House within the first ten days of the permitted period of residence, his/her permission will be cancelled. If accompanying family member does not move into the International House within three months from the first day of the permitted period of residence, permission for residence will be cancelled. In both cases, an occupant will need to vacate his/her allocated room.
