



(1) Use of Bicycles

Get bicycle insurance for your protection!!

Numerous students use bicycles daily. Recently there has been an increase in the number of bicycle-related accidents and accidents resulting in high compensation cases.

Please follow the rules when using a bicycle, and have bicycle insurance in case of emergencies.



(2) Drivers License

Traffic accidents involving international students occur every year.

Please do not drive a motorcycle or car unless it is essential to avoid traffic accidents.



If you need to drive a vehicle, a Japanese driver's license may be issued based on a driver's license obtained in a foreign country. For more information, including the documents required for application, contact the Okinawa Prefectural Police
Driver's License Center.

Traffic rules on campus

- *When entering the campus by car or motorcycle, a permit is required.
- *The maximum speed for vehicles on campus is 20 km/h.
- *No helmets are allowed on motorcycles.

You are required to observe the rules of good manners.





(3) Car insurance and Garage Certificate

If you need to drive a car or motorcycle, you have to have **compulsory insurance** (liability insurance) and voluntary insurance and ensure that you are covered.

Note that a "Garage Certificate," a document proving that the vehicle has a place to be stored, is required when purchasing a car. (For light vehicles, a garage certificate may not be necessary depending on the municipality.)

Please note that you cannot receive a "Garage Certificate" for parking in the Senbaru







Please consult with your supervisor well in advance of purchasing a car or motorcycle, taking these matters into consideration.




(4) Housing Insurance Policy

Most apartments in Japan require a "joint guarantor" at the time of contract when renting.

In principle, you must find a joint guarantor by yourself. However, if it is difficult to find someone on your own, the University of the Ryukyus will accept a joint guarantor for international students' apartment rental contracts under certain conditions.

≪Application Requirements≫

- 1 Students enrolled at the University of the Ryukyus (undergraduate, graduate, and research students)
- 2 Resident status must be "Student".
- ③ The applicant must join the Japan Educational Exchanges and Services (JEES) "Comprehensive Compensation for Foreign Students' Housing".

(5) Methods of Waste Disposal

In Japan, waste must be separated into several types and disposed of separately. The method of separating waste differs in each municipality, so please read the "Garbage Separation and Collection" pamphlet for your area carefully. If you do not follow the proper procedure, they will not take your waste. This can also cause trouble with residents.

Waste is mainly classified into the following four categories. Please visit the municipality's website where you live for more information on what falls into what category.

- 1. Burnable garbage
- 2. Non-burnable garbage
- 3. Recyclables
- 4. Large Items
