To All International Students,

We are pleased to announce that rooms at the International House will be available for rent. Those wishing to reside at the International House should read the following information before submitting their applications.

1. Rooms and Period of Residence:

Couple Room: 1 (Rent 25,000 yen per month)

2. Eligibility:

International students attending the University of the Ryukyus, their spouses, and children (Limited to children who are not in school at the time of application.)

3. Period of Residence: From June 1, 2023 (Thu.) to March 15, 2024 (Fri.)

4. What to submit:

- ① Application form for Residence at International House
- ② Copy of student ID
- ③ Copy of residence Card
- (4) Questionnaire Sheet

5. Application Period: From May24, 2023 (Wed.) to May 30, 2023 (Tue.)

6. Place to submit the form:

Application forms should be submitted to the Global Education Section. (General Education Building #1)

7. Selection Process:

The selection of residents will be made in the following order. If applicants have the same conditions, the residents will be selected by lottery.

- ① Those who have never lived in the International House before
- 2 Those who will complete their studies in September 2023.
- ③ Those who have lived in the International House for a short period will be given priority.

8. Selection of residents.:

May 31, 2023 (Wed.)

- * Application can only be made if you plan to move in with your spouse and/or children.
- * If you need to apply for a COE for a family member living with you, please submit your application by the end of May. If the application is not confirmed by the end of May, the residence permit may be canceled.

* <u>The applicant who has been approved for residence must move in within ten days of the start of the approved</u> period as indicated on the residence permit, or the residence permit will be canceled. The permit will also be revoked if, for any reason, the applicant's family cannot move in and live with the applicant within three months.
