Kainan University

1. Student Exchange Program

The aim of the student exchange program is not only to enhance the mutual collaboration between Kainan University (KNU) and its worldwide partner universities, but also to strengthen learning experiences of students in the partner universities as well as to increase their communication skills in Chinese or English.

1.1 Qualification of Application for the Exchange Program

- Students who study in their home universities are eligible to apply for the exchange program and are recommended by their home universities.
- Students who wish to study Chinese or the courses taught in English at KNU, however, those who undertake English taught courses are required to provide TOEFL or other language certificates (please refer to the required documents in Section 1.5).

1.2 Term Structure of Academic Year

Each student is permitted to choose one or two semesters studying at KNU as follows:

Option A: Fall semester admission (September to January)

Option B: Spring semester admission (February to July)

Option C: One-year course of two semester admission (September to July)

Option D: One-year course of two semester admission (February to January)

Note: Semesters will be divided according to the Spring Festival (Chinese New Year). The first or fall semester starts from September to January of the next year, and the second or spring semester is from February to July. Since the time of the Spring Festival varies according to the time of the lunar calendar, the end of the semester is adjusted every year. In addition, we recommend Options A and C instead of Options B and D because many of 1-year taught courses at KNU start from the fall semester.

1.3 Deadlines of Application

- Options A and C: May 31st each year
- Options B and D: November 30th each year

1.4 Course Information

One course is normally worth 2 or 3 credits and meets 2 or 3 hours per week over 18 weeks in one semester. A minimum of 15 credits must be taken each semester, but no more than 25 credits. If you wish to take elective courses less than 15 credits or more

than 25 credits, please contact the International Office at KNU.

Exchange students can choose all courses of the university. Most exchange students take courses at the Department of Applied Chinese and all courses taught in English offered by the International Honors Program (IHP). To bear in mind, to enroll in IHP courses, a TOEFL iBT score of 35~45 is required. If you have a TOEIC score of 600~700 or an IELTS score of 5.0 or above, these scores can be used instead of the TOEFL score.

1.5 Required Documents

- (1) Exchange Application Form (with a photo 4 x 3 cm)
- (2) Study plan in English or Japanese.
- (3) Autobiography in English or Japanese.
- (4) Certificate of Study in English or Japanese.
- (5) Transcripts of each semester in English or Japanese.
- (6) Financial Statement / Official Bank Statement (more than US\$ 3000 under the name of the applicant or his/her guardian).
- (7) Letters of Recommendation in English or Japanese, which should be addressed with the name of the president of the university where the student is studying.
- (8) Passport copy (with the front photo page and please note the expiry date).
- (9) Letter of Guarantee.
- (10) 4 ID photos (length: 4cm x width: 3cm) with white background, excluding the one photo attached on the application form.
- (11) A copy of TOEFL, TOEIC or IELTS certificate is required for enrolling into IHP courses.
- (12) Original medical certificate in English only must be submitted by email one month before arrival in Taiwan. Please use the specified format (Form B) and submit the original copy upon arrival. The validity period of the medical certificate is 3 months, please have the medical check done within one month before arrival.
- (13) Flight information (please provide the information to KNU at least 1 month in advance).
- (14) A copy of Accident Insurance certificate for Overseas Travel (for study purposes), submit it at least 1 month in advance. There is no limit on insurance company or amount of insurance, but all exchange students must purchase overseas travel insurance before coming to Taiwan.
- (15) Student's Dormitory Application Form: if you would like to apply for an on-campus dormitory of KNU, you are required to fill out the form. Alternatively,

if you wish to apply for private apartments that have cooperation with KNU, please contact us.

(16) Mailing Address: Documents related to the admission, such as admission permit, will be mailed directly to your university.

Note: As for the documents mentioned above, please ask the in-charge person of your university to scan the documents into PDF and send them to KNU by email. After confirming, please send the original documents to KNU by EMS.

1.6 Procedure of Application and Admission (take admission in September 2022 as an example, without the impact of COVID-19)

- May 31: Application deadline.
- June 1: Document review.
- End of June: Send admission letters and mail them to partner universities.
- Early July: Apply for a student visa at Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in Japan.
- Early September: come to Taiwan for entry procedures, ARC application, etc.
- In early September, freshmen orientation and formal classes will be held.

1.7 Time of Arrival in Taiwan and Return to Your Home Country

Exchange students are required to enter Taiwan with a student visa and apply for an ARC within 15 days at National Immigration Agency of the Ministry of the Interior. Students will be fined if they do not apply for an ARC within that time. The university will apply for the residence permit uniformly. Therefore, if possible, please come to Taiwan on the date we specify. Please note that an exchange student is a regular student with student status in the university, so at the end of the exchange period, the student must complete the process of leaving the university. Students can apply for the relevant procedures starting from the final examination week of the semester. Due to the time required to complete the process, students' flights back home must be scheduled for at least one week after the final exam.

2 Kainan Chinese Language Center

Founded in 2005, Kainan Chinese Language Center is located on the Taoyuan campus of KNU. With convenient transportation and in close proximity to Taoyuan and Taipei Aerotropolis, Kainan Chinese Language Center is the best place for foreign students to learn Mandarin. We provide comprehensive language learning services: all the classes are small-sized, and students are guided by well-trained teachers with rich teaching experience. We value the learning effectiveness of students and help them to successfully pass the TOCFL test so that they can continue their studies at universities

in Taiwan. Also, our center regularly holds exchange activities and cultural tours, enabling our students to adapt to the new environment in Taiwan as soon as possible.

3. Fees of Tuition, Dormitory, Insurance, and other fees

- Tuition: Exchange students are not required to pay tuition and miscellaneous fees at KNU.
- Accommodation: KNU provides students with on-campus dormitories or private apartments that are in cooperation with KNU. All rent and deposit should be paid by students. Please refer to the following table:

Note: Students who return to Japan several times during the exchange period or for more than 30 days at a time will lose their eligibility for the National Health Insurance and must re-enroll in the NT \$3,000 insurance for six months. If a student has a traffic accident or becomes seriously ill and does not have the national Health Insurance, the medical expenses will be very high. Therefore, it is recommended that students who exchange for one year should enroll in the National Health Insurance in the second half of the period of study.

Public transportation:

From Taoyuan International Airport:

- Taxi: The taxi fare is around NT\$ 500. The rate might be higher late at night. .
- Bus: Take Ubus heading to Taiwan High Speed Rail (THSR) Taoyuan Station, and get off at the terminal. Transferring onto the THSR shuttle bus heading to Taoyuan Train Station, and get off at Ba Jiao Dian. Walk along Xinxing Street for about 5 minutes and turn right at Kainan Road. (Some runs of the THSR shuttle bus stop at KNU.)

From Taoyuan Train Station:

- Taxi: The taxi fare is around NT\$250. The rate might be higher late at night.
- Bus 5086B: Get on at Tao Garden Hotel and get off at Ba Jiao Dian. Walk along Xinxing Street for about 5 minutes and turn right at Kainan Road.
- KNU Shuttle Bus (KNU--Taoyuan Train Station): Get on at FE21 Department Store and get off at KNU.
- It takes about 20 minutes by bus from Taoyuan Railway Station. Get off at “KNU, Bajaodian” stop, then enter Xinxing Street at the traffic light at the intersection of Yong’an Road and Xinxing Street, and walk along Xinxing

Street for about 5 minutes to arrive at KNU.

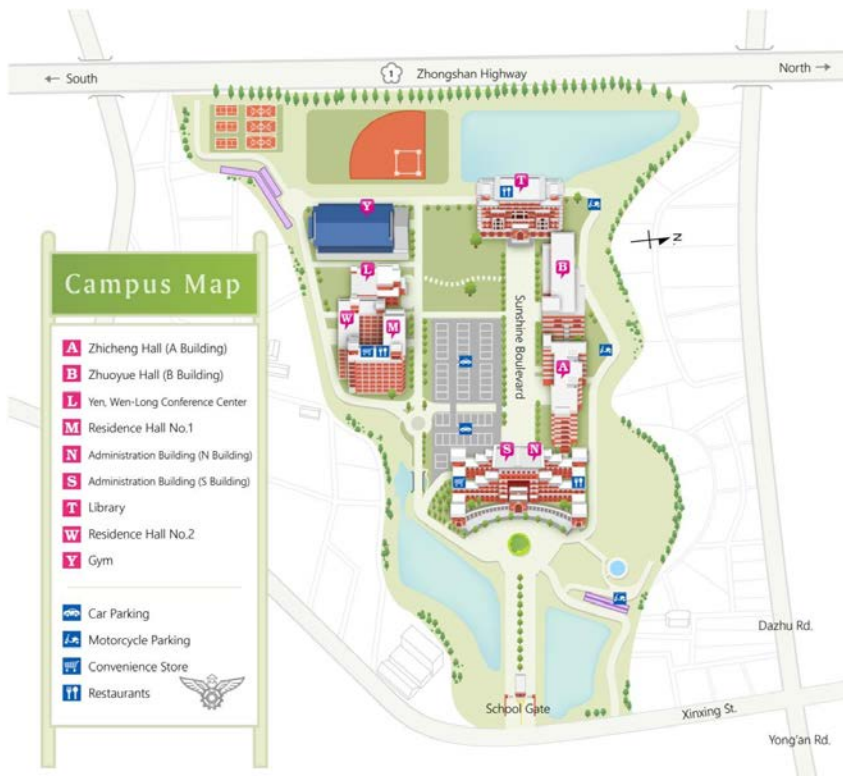
From High Speed Rail Taoyuan Station:

After getting off at the High Speed Rail Taoyuan Station, you can take the “High Speed Rail Free Express Bus” or “Rout 206 Taoyuan-High Speed Rail Taoyuan Station” bus and get off at the “KNU, Bajiaodian” stop, then enter Xinxing Street at the traffic light at the intersection of Yong'an Road and Xinxing Street, and walk along Xinxing Street for about 5 minutes to KNU.

1. 學生交換留學計畫

學生交換留學計畫的目的不僅是加強開南大學與其海外姊妹校的合作關係，而且還可以培養學生的國際觀、提昇學生的學習經驗、強化他們的中文或英文溝通能力。

1.1 申請資格：

- 在開南大學的姊妹校就讀並獲得姊妹校推薦的學生。
- 有意在開南大學學習中文或修習英語授課的學生(修習全英授課之課程需繳交托福等語言成績證明)(詳細內容請參閱 1.5)。

1.2 留學期間

A Plan: 第一學期入學之半年課程(9 月至次年 1 月)

B Plan: 第二學期入學之半年課程(2 月至 7 月)

C Plan: 第一學期入學之一年課程(9 月至次年 7 月)

D Plan: 第二學期入學之一年課程(2 月至次年 1 月)

※本校學期的時間以春節(農曆新年)的時間做為區隔，8 月至次年 1 月為第 1 學期，2 月至 7 月為第 2 學期。由於春節的時間會依據農曆時間的變化而有所不同，因此每學期結束的時間每年都會進行調整。另外，由於本校許多科目都是以全年修課為前提進行課程規劃，比起 B Plan 和 D Plan，我們比較推薦 A 計劃和 C 計劃。

1.3 申請截止日

A Plan • C Plan：每年 5 月 31 日

B Plan • D Plan：每年 11 月 30 日

1.4 學分數及修讀的課程

本校一學期共 18 周；交換生每學期必須選修至少 15 學分，但不得超過 25 學分；一門科目採計 2 或 3 學分，每周上課時間為 2 或 3 小時。如果您最後想選修的學分少於 15 學分或多於 25 學分，請與開南國際處聯繫。基本上交換生可以選修學校所有的課程。根據以往的經驗，交換生大多會選修應用華語系及以英

語授課的國際榮譽學程(簡稱 IHP)提供的所有課程。若想選修 IHP 課程,TOEFL iBT 成績必須達到 35~45 分左右,若是學生有 TOEIC 成績 600~700 分左右或是 IELTS 成績 5.0 以上,可用其成績單代替 TOEFL iBT 成績。

- (10)4 張白底證件照(長 4 cm x 寬 3 cm) * 不包含申請表上黏貼的那 1 張證件照。
- (11)選修 IHP 課程者需繳交托福成績單,也可以用多益或雅思的成績單代替托福成績單。
- (12)健康診斷書正本(限英文) *請務必在抵達台灣 1 個月前以電子郵件繳交。請務必使用指定格式(乙表),並於來台時提交正本。體檢證明有效期限為 3 個月,請在抵台前一個月內檢查。
- (13)航班資訊 * 同上(至少提前 1 個月繳交)
- (14)海外旅遊(留學)意外傷害保險證明影本 * 同上(至少提前 1 個月繳交)
※不限定保險公司與保險金額,但所有交換生在來台前都必須購買海外旅遊保險。
- (15)宿舍申請表 * 若想預約本校合作之民間公寓,請聯繫開南大學國際處。
- (16)郵寄地址 *入學相關文件本校將會直接郵寄至交換學生的母國學校,如入學許可等。

1.6 從申請到入學的流程(以 2022 年 9 月入學為例,無疫情影響之下)

- 5 月 31 日:申請資料截止日
- 6 月 1 日:文件審核
- 6 月底:發送入學許可並郵寄給姊妹學校
- 7 月初:至台灣駐日經濟文化代表處申請簽證

- 9月初：來台辦理入台手續、居留證（ARC）申請等
- 9月上旬進行新生說明會及開學正式上課

1.7 來台時間及返國手續

交換學生必須持學生簽證進入台灣，並且需於 15 日內至中華民國內政部移民署辦理居留證（ARC），若無在此規定時間內辦理居留證(ARC)，將會被罰款。開南大學會統一辦理居留證，因此，我們非常建議交換學生請在我們指定的日期搭機來台灣。請注意，交換留學生在本校為有學籍的正規學生，因此在交換留學期間結束時，需請學生辦理離校手續，從學期期末考試周開始即可辦理相關手續。由於辦理手續需要花費一定的時間，回國的航班最快必須安排在期末考試後的一周。

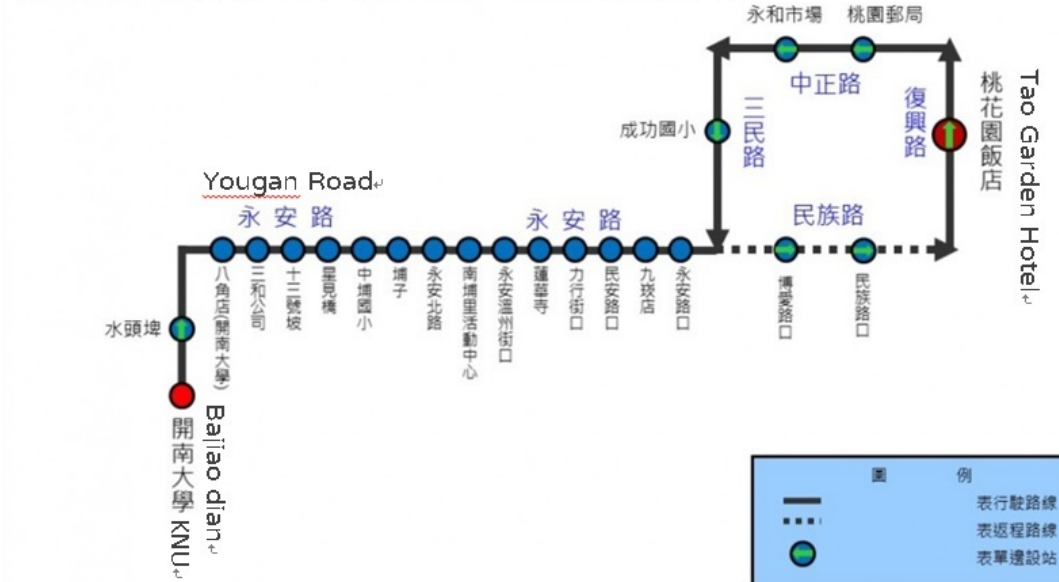

- ✧ All rent and deposit should be paid by students.
- ✧ Please refer to the following table:

Insurance and other expenses



◆ Exchange **for one semester**:

1. Before coming to Taiwan, Student need to purchase overseas insurance.
2. Exchange students are required to take out student insurance, which costs NTD 3,000 (6 months)

◆ Other expenses :

Students must pay for their own personal expenses such as airfare, meals, textbooks, etc. ◦

◆ Reference : Living expenses are about NTD.5,000-8,000 per month

※Note: Living expenses will vary according to each person's living habits.



Insurance and other expenses(2 semesters)



◆ Exchange for two semesters :

1. Before coming to Taiwan, students need to purchase overseas insurance.

2. Exchange students are required to pay for a student insurance which costs NTD 3,000 (6 months)

✧ Submit your receipt and proof of diagnosis to apply for insurance.

✧ Medical expenses are pay as you go, and the maximum application amount is NTD.1,000.

After coming to Taiwan for 6 months, exchange students need to enroll in the National Health Insurance. Pay once a semester, NTD.4956 (6 months).

Required documents



1. Exchange Application Form (with a photo 4 x 3 cm)
 2. Study plan and Autobiography in English or Japanese
 3. Certificate of Study and transcripts of each semester in English or Japanese
 4. Financial Statement / Official Bank Statement (more than US\$ 3000 under the name of the applicant or his/her guardian)
 5. Passport copy (with the front photo page and please note the expiry date).
 6. Letter of Guarantee
 7. 4 ID photos (length: 4cm x width: 3cm) with white background, excluding the one photo attached on the application form.
 8. A copy of TOEFL, TOEIC or IELTS certificate is required for enrolling into IHP courses(only for those who join IHP courses)
 9. Original medical certificate in English only must be submitted by email one month before arrival in Taiwan. Please use the specified format (Form B) and submit the original copy upon arrival. The validity period of the medical certificate is 3 months, please have the medical check done within one month before arrival.
 10. Flight information (please provide the information to KNU at least 1 month in advance)
 11. A copy of Accident Insurance certificate for Overseas Travel (for study purposes), submit it at least 1 month in advance
 12. Student's Dormitory Application Form: if you would like to apply for an on-campus dormitory of KNU, you are required to fill out the form(Only for dormitory applicants)
- ※if you wish to apply for private apartments that have cooperation with KNU, please contact us.



Application Notes and Process



- ◆ When submitting application documents, be sure to provide a mailing address.
✧ Admission related documents will be mailed directly to the partner universities.
- ◆ Before sending the application documents, please ask the window in charge of the partner universities to scan the documents into a PDF file and send documents to Kainan University by mail. After confirming that the documents is correct, please send the original copy to Kainan University by EMS.

Procedure of Application and Admission (take admission in September 2022 as an example, without the impact of COVID-19)

May 31: Application deadline

June 1: Document review.

End of June: Send admission letters and mail them to partner universities.

Early July: Apply for a student visa at Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in Japan.

Early September: come to Taiwan for entry procedures, ARC application, etc

In early September, freshmen orientation and formal classes will be held



Time of Arrival in Taiwan and Return to Your Home Country



- ◆ Exchange students are required to enter Taiwan with a student visa and apply for an ARC within 15 days at National Immigration Agency of the Ministry of the Interior. Students will be fined if they do not apply for an ARC within that time. The university will apply for the residence permit uniformly. Therefore, if possible, please come to Taiwan on the date we specify. ◦
- ◆ Please note that an exchange student is a regular student with student status in the university, so at the end of the exchange period, the student must complete the process of leaving the university. Students can apply for the relevant procedures starting from the final examination week of the semester. Due to the time required to complete the process, students' flights back home must be scheduled for at least one week after the final exam.



Transportation



◆ From Taoyuan International Airport:

Taxi: The taxi fare is around NT\$ 500. The rate might be higher late at night. .

Bus: Take Ubus heading to Taiwan High Speed Rail (THSR) Taoyuan Station, and get off at the terminal. Transferring onto the THSR shuttle bus heading to Taoyuan Train Station, and get off at Ba Jiao Dian. Walk along Xinxing Street for about 5 minutes and turn right at Kainan Road. (Some runs of the THSR shuttle bus stop at KNU.)



Transportation



◆ From Taoyuan Train Station :

Students who take the train or bus can take the train to Taoyuan Railway Station, then walk to the "Tao Garden Hotel" on Fuxing Road, and transfer to Taoyuan Bus No. 5086 to get to the school.

◆ From High Speed Rail Taoyuan Station :

After getting off at the High Speed Rail Taoyuan Station, you can take the "High Speed Rail Free Express Bus" or "Rout 206 Taoyuan-High Speed Rail Taoyuan Station" bus and get off at the "KNU, Bajiaodian" stop, then enter Xinxing Street at the traffic light at the intersection of Yong'an Road and Xinxing Street, and walk along Xinxing Street for about 5 minutes to KNU.

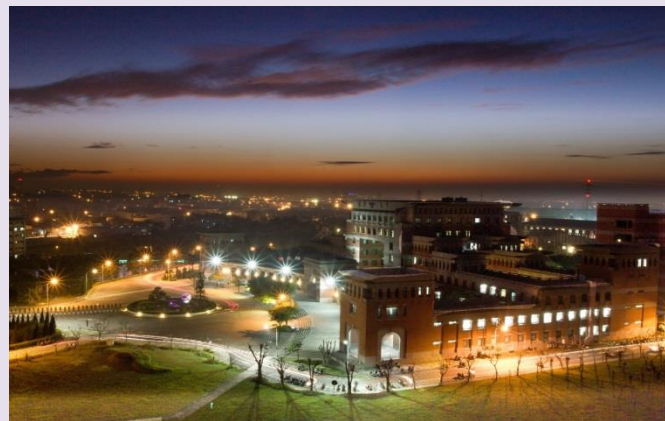

- ◆持學生簽證入台需於15日內辦妥居留證(ARC)。若未於時間內辦理將會被罰鍰，交換留學生的居留證將由本校統一辦理，因此希望同學能配合指定日期搭機來台。
- ◆交換留學生在本校為有學籍的正規學生，因此在交換留學期間結束時，需請學生辦理離校手續(退學)。從學期期末考試周開始可以辦理相關手續。由於辦理手續需要花費一定的時間，回國航班最快也必須安排在期末考試後的一周。
